

### Cutting Requirements / Information

1. Cut all merchantable jack pine, oak, and aspen. Avoid damage to residual maple, or young pine. Large cull oaks may be left.
2. Sale is bound by red paint or road.
3. Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees and limbs that will make at least 1 100" pulp stick 4 inches on small end.
4. No whole tree harvesting. Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground.
5. No cutting, hauling, or forwarding during wet periods when rutting occurs.
6. Due to oak wilt no wood shall be sold to private individuals unless the bark is off or loose.
7. Landings, roads, or turn-arounds must be cleared of slash and leveled.
8. This is a lump sum sale for all products.
9. Access road on west side is on the State Forest. Permission must be obtained to use their road. Otherwise a stub road may be pushed in off 248<sup>th</sup>.
