

Cutting Requirements / Information

1. Harvest all trees marked with orange paint that will make at least one 100" pulp stick. This is 2nd thinning.
2. Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees that will make at least 1 pulp stick 3 inches on small end.
3. No whole tree harvesting. Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground.
4. No cutting, hauling, or forwarding during wet periods if rutting occurs.
5. If cut between May 1 and October 1, decked wood must be hauled within 3 weeks of cutting.
6. Leave all down wood, snags, and den trees that are not a hazard.
7. Any road building, if needed, must be approved by the County Forest Administrator. Landings or turn-arounds must be cleared of slash and leveled to allow seeding.
8. This is a scaled sale utilizing the mill scale ticket system. County may scale on the landing at their discretion.
9. ATV and Horse Trail must remain passable and free of slash and debris.
