RFEs have been determined for Big and Little Butternut Lakes based on the survey information supplied. The RFEs are tied to B.M. 1166-A at 1213.03 ft. NGVD-29.

The RFE for Big Butternut Lake is 1215.4 feet NGVD-29.

The RFE for Little Butternut Lake is 1210.3 feet NGVD-29.

The cooperation shown between the Lake Association, Polk County Zoning and Polk County Land Surveying made the determination of these RFEs possible.


