




► CATTAIL TRAIL


Amery to Almena

18 miles of trail, 12 in Polk County Trailhead at Amery. Rest rooms, picnic areas available at the trailhead. This trail has lots of wildlife along the trail. It is an old railroad bed with 6 bridges. This is also a multi-use trail. Open all year to ATVs AND MOTORCYCLES.



► STERLING TRAIL

Summer Only June 1st - Nov. 15th
7 miles of closed loop wooded trail.
No dirt bikes or horses.

Cattail	Open year-round	Spring-Summer-Fall
Clear Lake-Clayton	Open year-round	Spring-Summer-Fall
Sterling	June 1 - November 15 only	Not Allowed
