

ATV/UTV Routes through Polk County Cities and Villages - 04/2019

City of Amery - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed on streets

City of Saint Croix Falls - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed on limited roads per ordinance

Village of Balsam Lake - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed except for STH 46 and CTH I from Main Street to just past Paradise Landing

Village of Centuria - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed except for Main Street from Superior Ave to Polk Ave

Village of Clayton - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed in accordance with Village Ordinance V1 Chapter 494

Village of Clear Lake - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed only on approved routes through the village

Village of Dresser - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed under Municipal Code Sec 7.14

Village of Frederic - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed on all village streets but excludes state highways

Village of Luck - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed except for main street and state highways

Village of Milltown - ATV/UTV are allowed on routes planned by the ATV club

Village of Osceola - ATV/UTV traffic is allowed in accordance with Village Ordinance 19-01
