Amendment to the Parks and Navigable Waters Ordinance

WHEREAS Polk County has enacted the Parks and Navigable Waters Ordinance, which, amongst things, regulates the times of usage of the parks, special use areas and waysides of Polk County.

WHEREAS Section 12-1-1c)(20) of said ordinance currently provides that such areas shall be open from 6:00 am to 10:00 on each day of the year.

THEREFORE, the Polk County Board of Supervisors does ordain to amend Section 12-1-1(c)(20) to state:

Hours: All parks, special use areas and waysides shall be open to the public between from one half hour after sunrise to one half hour before sunset from May 1 through October 15. Such areas shall be closed from October 16 through April 30. The Department will make available upon request a table of sunrise and sunset times. No person may enter or be on such lands outside of such times, except for campers on designated campsites or persons enroute to designated campsites, or persons transporting watercraft to and from designated landings. Time shall be computed pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Sections 175.09 or 175.095, whichever is applicable.

Effective Date: The amendment to the ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
