

WELCOME TO THE AHLGREN WILDLIFE PRESERVE AND RECREATION AREA

This peaceful parcel of land is set aside to preserve it as it may have been found many centuries ago, when only native wildlife and the Native Americans walked it. Then, in the 1800's countless immigrant settlers, mostly from Northern Europe, began to come here to build new lives in what is now the beautiful piece of Wisconsin, named Polk County, and known as "A Gift of the Glaciers".

Enjoy the woods, water, and wildlife, of this 180 acres, donated to Polk County in 2013 by Janet (Stever) Ahlgren, and her late husband, David Ahlgren, who purchased this land in 1975. David, son of Henry Ahlgren, was a grandson of Swedish immigrants, Carl and Hilda Ahlgren, who came to Polk County in 1913 and raised their family of four children on a small farm near Frederic, in the northern part of the County. Carl and Hilda's children; Henry, Theodore, Gilbert, and Lillie, each became well known citizens of Wisconsin and beyond, and each of these children of Swedish immigrants, like countless others, left significant marks on the State of Wisconsin - great footprints for others to follow in.

This Preserve is dedicated to the memory of the Ahlgren family, and to all of the others who have made Polk County and Wisconsin so great. Enjoy your visit here, with the intent, as much as possible, to leave it as untouched, and as beautifully peaceful and abundant in its many riches, as those early settlers found it, back in the 1800's, when they first met the natives, settled their communities, began farming, and raised their families in this wonderful land.








The Preserve viewing south from US Hwy 8.
