

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE POLK COUNTY "WILD RIVER" ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of Polk County do hereby resolve and ordain as follows:

A. Section I, of the "Wild River" ordinance adopted by the Polk County Board of Supervisors on February 23, 1977, (Resolution 16) and subsequently amended by the Polk County Board of Supervisors on April 20, 1977, (Resolution 32) is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

SECTION I. TRESPASSING IN CERTAIN AREAS PROHIBITED. Except to the extent hereinafter authorized, it shall be unlawful for any person, other than authorized personnel, to enter into or remain on any lands which are controlled by Polk County pursuant to the terms of a lease and agreement with Northern States Power Company and National Park Service. Said lands are more specifically described as follows:

All lands lying West and South of the River Road and between the River Road and the normal high water mark of the East bank of the St. Croix River located in Sections 1 & 2, Range Nineteen (19) West, and Sections 6 and 7, Range Eighteen (18) West, all four of said Sections being in the Township of St. Croix Falls; and Sections 16, 21, 22, 27, 34 and 35, Range Nineteen (19) West, in the Town of Eureka;

ALSO INCLUDING:

All those portions of the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Sixteen (16), Range Nineteen (19) West of the Town of Eureka, lying East of the River Road; Except for the East Half of the Northeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16);

ALSO INCLUDING:

The East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16) Range Nineteen (19) West, in the Town of Eureka;

ALSO INCLUDING:

Government Lots 1 and 2, Section Four, (4), Range Nineteen (19) West, in the Town of Eureka;

ALSO INCLUDING:

All of Section Nine (9), Range Nineteen (19) West, Town of Eureka, except the East Half of the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of E $\frac{1}{2}$) of said Section Nine (9).

B. Sections II and III are hereby created to read as follows:

SECTION II. EXCEPTIONS TO GENERAL PROHIBITION ON TRESPASSING:

A. The following described area will be open for public use during daylight hours as hereinafter defined including public access to the St. Croix River:

That portion of Section Nine (9), Township Thirty-five (35) North, Range Nineteen (19) West, in the Town of Eureka, lying between the River Road and the East bank of the St. Croix River.

B. All lands described in this ordinance shall be open for fishing during daylight hours as hereinafter defined.

C. For the purposes of paragraphs A and B of this section daylight hours are defined as that portion of time running from 30 minutes prior to sunrise until 30 minutes after sunset. All lands described in this ordinance shall be closed for all purposes from 30 minutes after sunset until 30 minutes before sunrise.

SECTION III. INTOXICATED PERSONS PROHIBITED. No person who is in an intoxicated condition shall at any time enter into or remain on any of the lands which are described in this ordinance.

c. Sections II, III, IV, V and VI of the "Wild River" ordinance adopted by the Polk County Board of Supervisors on February 23, 1977 (Resolution 16) and subsequently amended by the Polk County Board of Supervisors on April 20, 1977 (Resolution 32) are hereby renumbered as Sections IV, V, VI, VII and VIII respectively.

These ordinance amendments shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
