

Resolution No. 75-08.

To Rescind Resolution 66-08, Polk County's Cash Handling Policy

WHEREAS, the Polk County Board of Supervisors passed Resolution 66-08 and adopted the Polk County Cash Handling Policy; and

WHEREAS, the adopted cash handling policy was adopted without the consideration of the impacts on or inputs of county departments; and

WHEREAS, in some instances, the application of the adopted county cash handling policy conflicts with state mandated cash handling policies and procedures in which county departments are presently adhering to; and

WHEREAS, it was the intent of the Polk County Board of Supervisors to adopt a cash handling policy that does not contravenes federal or state cash handling policies and procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Polk County Board of Supervisors rescinds Resolution 66-08.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Polk County Board of Supervisors refers the Cash Handling Policy to each respective governing committee and such committees shall receive the input of its respective departments regarding the policy's impact on departmental operations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Polk County Board of Supervisors will consider again the Cash Handling Policy only after it receives the input from departments with respect to the policy's impact on departmental operations.




