To Rescind Polk County Resolution No. 65-08 and Proclaim Support
for Enactment of Health Care Form Legislation

WHEREAS, the Polk County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 65-08 which called for an advisory referendum on health care reform legislation; and

WHEREAS, the holding of such a referendum has a direct financial impact upon the residents of Polk County and the financial status of the government of Polk County; and

WHEREAS, Polk County has alternative means in proclaiming its support for health care reform legislation that are less costly to Polk County residents and the Government of Polk County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Polk County Board of Supervisors rescinds Resolution 65-08.





